Dear Brother Frank

We ar-

ived at Yokohama Mar 4<sup>th</sup>  
and had a grand reception.

All of the War Ships saluted  
and at Counted 15 ships deco-  
rated with flags. Jards were  
manned on board Eleven Men  
of War as our Steamer en-  
tered the harbour. It was one  
of the prettiest sights I ever  
saw. The Emperor sent  
off two Princes to invite his  
majesty to be his guest during  
our stay in Japan.
