After the month of Welehu comes the Makahiki festival, and Lono-i-ka-makahiki was its god. He was a god that was fond of dances and other sports indulged in by the people. These things pleased him. Lono-i-ka-makahiki was a god of Hawaii. He was represented by a wooden idol. He was the feather-decked god that went around the islands of Hawaii and Maui. The work that he did was to levy taxes on the land, -for large lands, hogs, bird feathers, and fish nets. That was a strange way to behave. All that has been done away with.
