Matters of private rather than public interest, have occupied the House of Nobles the past two weeks, during which the wills of their late Excellencies, T. Haalilio and J. A. Kuakini, have been admitted to Probate.

The houses of Nobles and of Representatives will formally convene on Tuesday next, (the 20th) at 12 o'clock M. His Majesty will deliver in person a speech on that occasion. The new royal standard will be raised for the first time upon the arrival of His Majesty at the Hall of Assembly, which for this especial ceremony, will be the house to the East of the Fort, where the Lower Judges usually hold their sittings. The Hall will be open to the public.
