The Queen Emma Collection, the J. S. Emerson Collection were obtained by Hon. Chas. R. Bishop before the founding of the Museum and so were part of the original specimens. The Collection of the A. B. C. F. M. of Boston was afterwards purchased by the founder and presented to the Museum. The Hawaiian Government Collection was given to this Museum in the latter part of 1890 when Kalakaua was on the throne. Keelikolani's Collection came through Hon. Chas. R. Bishop. At auction the Museum purchased the Geo. H. Dole Collection.

Bishop Museum Catalog and Accession Book was compiled by Allen M. Wolcott under the direction of Dr. William T. Brigham. The Director's Report for 1901, (Occasional Papers I (5): p.5) states: "Mr. Wolcott has completed the great task of rewriting the accession book, comparing each specimen with the description and number in the most painstaking manner."
