These are the people at King George's audience, except James Young and Kauluhaimalama.

About James Young, why he did not arrive in England with the Kings party. Jean Rives did not want James Young in the party because he (J.Y.) was the King's interpreter, and J. Rives wanted to use his influence over the King which he could not do if J. Young was along. So they left James Young at Valparaiso. J. Young knew this was J. Rives doings. He tried to get on any vessel that was going to England and worked his way over, on his arrival in England both the King and Queen were dead. He told someone in England on his arrival that he belonged to the Kings party, they did not believe him, but took him there anyway. When the folks saw J. Young they all wailed, sure recognition that he belonged to the party. Jean Rives did not come back with the party, they soon found out his trickery and left him there.
